### Profile

I am eager to secure an industrial placement in the research and development of polymers and organic synthesis. ### Education

#### University of Strathclyde (2012-Present)

I am entering third year to study MChem Chemistry with Drug Discovery. Classes this year cover, Physical Chemistry, Organic, Spectroscopy, Structures and Inorganic Chemistry, as well as with labs in Physical and Applied Chemistry, Organic and Inorganic Chemistry and Drug Discovery, this included, TLC Optimisation, Refluxing, work-ups, IR, NMR and UV/Vis Spectroscopy

Second year classes were focused on the Physical, Inorganic, Organic and Spectroscopic side of Chemistry. I attended classes in Pharmaceuticals and Pharmaceutical science and drug development. An overall pass with merit was achieved. Practical laboratories resulted in me achieving a mark of 88% in Practical Organic and Inorganic and 97% in Practical Physical and Applied Chemistry and Chemical Analysis. I also achieved a certificate of excellence for laboratory skills, which involved being accurate, precise and working to experimental deadlines.

In first year I covered a wide range of classes in Principles and Practices of Chemistry. An average of 76% was achieved over both semesters. In my Molecular Properties class I achieved 85%. I also carried out laboratory work individually and in pairs managing to achieve a mark of 94% that resulted in me attaining a certificate of excellence for laboratory skills.

I have also achieved an HNC in Computer Science in 2013.

#### Stonelaw High School (2006-2012)

I achieved 5 Highers, Chemistry A, Computing C, English B, Mathematics A and physics B, with six standard grades one's a two and a three.

In fifth year I was a Prefect for my School House. In sixth year I was House Captain both being elected by teachers and my peers. Being House Captain gave me the responsibility of having to organise my house whenever we had duties to undertake. I was involved in multiple Citizenship Awards such as Buddying, Peacemaking and Classroom Mentoring. My buddying involved me helping a first year pupil settle into school. I assured him I was
